## FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

The Form I-20 (F-1 visa) or DS-2019 (J-1 visa) cannot be issued until an acceptable Financial Affidavit of Responsibility (FAR) Form and Proof of Funds have been received and verified by Illinois Tech. The Proof of Funds may be in the form of a letter bearing the bank's signature or a bank statement of financial transactions stating readily available funds. The required minimum expenses amount is specific to the I-20/DS-2019 as an "estimate" of expenses for the student's first academic year in their program. A student's actual tuition payment amount may differ from the amount listed on the I-20/DS-2019.
